



Geophysical Society of Alaska Scholarships

This spring, the Geophysical Society of Alaska has scholarships available for deserving junior or senior Alaska undergraduates or graduate students studying geophysics or earth science at Alaska universities. Consideration will also be given to Alaska residents studying geophysics or earth science at outside universities. The amount of each scholarship this year will be up to \$2,000. Individual merit will dictate the exact amount of each award based on the consensus of our Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility:

- 1) You must be studying at an Alaska university, or be an Alaska resident studying at an outside university.
- 2) You must be a full-time junior/senior undergraduate or graduate student *taking at least 12 undergraduate credit hours or 9 graduate credit hours*.
- 3) Your academic emphasis is geophysics, earth science, or a very closely related natural science.

Applications Should Include:

1. A letter describing your personal and educational career goals, your interest in the earth sciences, your financial need, and how you would use the scholarship funds. Please include pertinent work history and extracurricular activities include volunteer activities.
2. Recent transcripts of all your college-level academic experience (unofficial copies will suffice). *Important:* You must describe the grading system used at that institution *and* a key for abbreviations.
3. A thesis proposal if you are a graduate student.
4. Two letters of recommendation from someone familiar with your academic record. A third letter may be included if it contains important additional information.

The judges will take into account *ALL* facets of the information received. Priority will be given to those motivated individuals with strong focus toward geophysics, earth science or a closely related natural science, as shown by their academic progress. **To be considered, applications should be marked to the attention of the Scholarship Committee and must be received no later than April 1, 2019.** Please send applications to estherbabcock@u.boisestate.edu or to the following address:
